

GETTING A LIBRARY CARD

A Lawton Public Library card is necessary to borrow library materials. Individuals may apply for a card at either the Main Library or the Branch.

An applicant is required to verify:

- proof of identity with a government-issued photo ID &
- proof of residency.



A current driver's license will suffice for both proof of identity and residency.

Other acceptable ways to prove residency include current (within the last 30 days):

- mortgage payment coupon, rent receipt, or lease agreement
- utility bill received by mail
- bank statement
- payroll check with printed address
- printed check
- letter received by mail

DATABASES

Information is a click away...

Databases are available in either the Main Library or Branch Library or from home with a valid library card unless otherwise indicated.

America's Newspapers provides access to thousands of newspaper articles.

Ancestry provides primary and secondary source material to support genealogical research. Available in the main library only.

Chilton Automotive provides automotive repair guides including wiring diagrams.

Ebscohost contains business, medical, educational, and governmental magazine articles, encyclopedia entries, and more.

Heritage Quest has family and local historical material to help genealogists.

World Cat allows users to place interlibrary loan requests on books and other materials not available at Lawton Public Library.

USING THE INTERNET

Renew your items and place holds by going to the library's website and clicking on Koha, the library's online catalog. Use your barcode and four-digit password.

Public computers are available at both the Main Library and the Branch Library. Individuals must have a library card and four-digit number to log onto the public computers.

If an individual does not have a library card, a guest pass can be provided with a valid picture ID.

Printing and copies are \$0.10/page.
