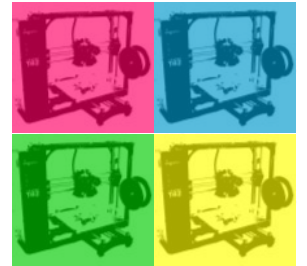

LARGE OBJECTS	50 – 75 grams	\$10.00
EXTRA LARGE OBJECTS	over 75 grams	\$0.15 per gram



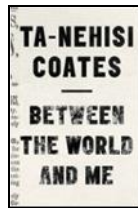

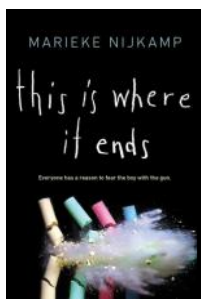
