

Learn how to get ebooks from the library with OverDrive Media console. We will have some devices pre-loaded with titles & appetizers will be served.



● LEVEL 2 READERS

Books have longer sentences, more vocabulary, & paragraphs for those that are starting to read, but still need help.

● LEVEL 3 READERS

Books have longer sentences, more difficult vocabulary, & more developed plots for readers that are starting to read alone.


● LEVEL 4 READERS

Books have challenging vocabulary, more complex sentences, & chapters for confident readers.


