### SAVE \$ ON ELECTRICITY

The Lawton Public Library has kilowatt meters to check out! Kilowatt meters are used to monitor electric consumption & help people save find ways to money on electrical costs.

Each kit includes a meter & complete operating instructions. The meters will be available for check out using your library card & can be borrowed for three weeks. The meters can be used on appliances such as fans, refrigerators, space heaters, televisions, computers, & printers. Basically, any device that plugs into a 120-volt AC outlet can be monitored using the kilowatt meter.


