



A New Year Means New Opportunities to Get Involved

The Stormwater program offers several ways for citizens to get involved.

1. Host a **stormwater presentation**. Our staff can tailor the talk for your specific organization and environmental topic.
2. **Adopt-A-Stream**. Organizations and community groups are encouraged to pick a section of Lawton's creeks and commit to picking up trash four times a year. The City provides all supplies and your group receives recognition.
3. Schedule a **drain marking** event. It is an easy activity where you glue plastic labels on storm drains to raise awareness that water entering the drain flows to the creek without treatment
4. Call the **Stormwater Hotline 581-3565**. You can leave a message for the staff 24-hours a day about stormwater concerns. Use this number to report illicit discharges and illegal dumping.


