

Oklahoma Mercury Thermostat Recycling Initiative

Covanta Tulsa, Locke Supply and the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) have partnered to provide a convenient way to responsibly recycle mercury containing thermostats in Oklahoma. Mercury is a heavy metal that represents a threat to human health and the environment when released. An average wall thermostat contains 4 grams of mercury, which is the equivalent of 800 compact fluorescent lights. Covanta, Locke Supply and ODEQ are committed to protecting our land, air and water. Preventing toxics like mercury from entering the waste stream plays a critical role in protecting our environment and water supply.
