



POLLUTION PREVENTION



In the City of Lawton, storm drains flow directly to local creeks (Wolf Creek, Numu Creek, East Cache Creek, Squaw Creek, Wrattton Creek, Mission Creek, Ninemile Creek, Goodyear Creek) into Red River and Lake Texhoma without treatment. Stormwater pollution is a serious problem for wildlife dependent on our waterways and for the people who live near streams or the bay. Some common sources of this pollution include spilled oil, fuel, fluids from vehicles and heavy equipment, construction debris, sediment, landscaping runoff containing pesticides or weed killers, and materials such as used motor oil, antifreeze, and paint products that people pour into a street or storm drain.
